

All those dancing there that night have undergone trial and affliction since. Father is dead, and Harry. Mr. Trezevant lies at Corinth with his skull fractured by a bullet; every young man there has been in at least one battle since, and every woman has cried over her son, brother, or sweetheart, going away to the wars, or lying sick and wounded. And yet we danced that night, and never thought of bloodshed! The week before Louisiana seceded, Jack Wheat stayed with us, and we all liked him so much, and he thought so much of us; — and last week — a week ago to-day — he was killed on the battle-field of Shiloh.

NEW LAUGH MAKER FOR BEERY - HATTON

Biscuits, mothers-in-law, and mountain-climbers are all funny, but Wallace Beery and Raymond Hatton, in the Alpine comedy drama, "Wife Savers," which opens at the Lyric Theater Monday are funnier than all of them, jointly or severally.

Beery takes the biscuits and climbs the mountains, in the garb of a Swiss yodeler, and the mother-in-law tries to induce him to share a boudoir with the bride he has wrongfully appropriated from Raymond Hatton, who is a second lieutenant in the same unit of the American army in which Beery is not only a buck private but a kitchen policeman as well.

This new Beery-Hatton opus is nonsense of purest ray serenade. Its architects had only one thought in mind and that was deep raucous laughter that would convulse the diaphragms of the customers, which it does successfully.

At the beginning Beery is Hatton's head waiter in a Brooklyn restaurant. The fortunes of war toss them both up on the Franco-Swiss border just as the armistice is signed.

Hatton goes home and assigns Wally behind to look after his girl. Wally does by marrying her almost immediately, but the marriage is really no doing of his own.

In the end as a pat they both lose the girl to a younger and handsomer rival, but not before they have staged

doctrines have not been returned because of "our inability to fix individual responsibility."

Chief of Police H. Leslie Quigg, now suspended, was indicted yesterday for murder, as was Detective R. L. Wood. These officers were added to the police colony at the county stockade, a group charged with murder which already consisted of Lieutenant M. A. Tibbitts, Detectives John Cardell and Tom Nasworth, and sergeants Nelson Ward and R. L. Gilsen. All indictments were concerned with deaths of persons with whom these indicted had contact in an official capacity.

Guy C. Revo, head of the detective department, last night was made acting chief and H. L. Arnold was named director of public safety. Arnold's first act was to order reinforcement of patrols in the negro districts, where resentment against recent police activities is said to be high.

The grand jury further charged that department investigation, which it called incomplete, said in part:

"In the taking of testimony regarding the department, it has been further disclosed that this (previously referred to) lack of morale in the police force has contributed in no small degree to the amazing growth of unlawful practices in the territory served by them, and while our efforts have been directed primarily to an inquiry regarding the handling of human beings we have been subjected to much information involving and connecting some branches of the police department with Miami's underworld. We were become thoroughly convinced that the open violations of law on the part of gamblers, bootleggers and houses of ill fame, are permitted because of an unquestionable alliance with many law enforcement officers."

Police methods of handling prisoners drew chief attention in the report and was described by the jurors' pronouncement as "terrifying and damnable."
