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Objective

The objective of this research report was to identify the biological father of Jeanie Maleski using autosomal DNA research and traditional genealogical methodology.

Background Information

Jeanie Lorainne Maleski, born Stephanie Lorainne Lang, was born 6 January 1943 in Salt Lake City, Salt Lake, Utah, United States; see Appendix Item 1.¹ Her biological mother, Lois Lee, a native of San Diego County, California, was married at age sixteen to Peter Fekke in 1940; see Appendix Item 2.²

When Jeanie was conceived, Peter was fighting in World War II, so he was not Jeanie's father.³ As is common with children born in such circumstances, Jeanie's birth certificate incorrectly recorded her father. The name of her father according to the birth certificate was Edward Stephen Lang; see Appendix Item 1.⁴

A man named Edward Stephen Lang was located in San Diego in 1942, but he was about 42 years older than Lois which makes him an unlikely candidate to be Jeanie's father.⁵ Furthermore, analysis of autosomal DNA testing completed by Jeanie's daughter did not provide any evidence of a connection to any members of the Lang family. Edward was most likely a family friend of Lois or Edna's.

After the birth, Lois and Jeanie returned to Lois's hometown in San Diego County where Jeanie was adopted by Lois's friend, Edna Maleski.⁶ Jeanie was recorded as Jeanie L. Maleski for her marriage to David H. Petersen on 16 June 1962.⁷ She did not learn of her adoption until her adult years, nor did she know that she had half-siblings who lived in the same county as her as a child. Jeanie met her biological mother but did not have the chance to meet her half-sister.

The identity of Jeanie's biological father has since been an unsolved mystery in the family. Family lore recalled that Jeanie's biological father might have been a soldier

who was stationed in San Diego during World War II since Edna and Lois knew and associated with many male soldiers.⁸ Lois died in 1988⁹ and Jeanie in 2003,¹⁰ so neither of them are available to interview for potential clues. See Appendix Item 3 for a copy of Jeanie's death certificate. Even when they were alive, the subject of Jeanie's biological father was not discussed in detail among family, and the surviving family members have very little helpful knowledge.¹¹ With little paper evidence of Jeanie's biological father, the family turned to DNA testing to solve this case.

Since Jeanie was unavailable for genetic testing, Jeanie's daughter and granddaughter took autosomal DNA tests. Kathy P., daughter of Jeanie Maleski, tested on *Ancestry*. Hazel S., daughter of Kathy P., tested on *Ancestry* and *23AndMe*.

Summary of Findings

A thorough analysis of the autosomal DNA results on *Ancestry* for Kathy P. revealed three matches who were proven to be descendants of the couple Robert Clark Hubbard and Florence Adelaide Hampton. This couple had six sons and two daughters who are all deceased and unavailable for DNA testing. These three DNA matches all descended from different Hubbard children. From the *Ancestry* results, two of the six brothers were eliminated as candidates for Jeanie's father, and a third was eliminated with traditional genealogical research.

Combined with the results of Hazel Scullin's autosomal *23AndMe* test, it can be concluded that Jeanie Maleski's biological father was one of Robert Clark Hubbard and Florence Adelaide Hampton's sons, most likely Donald Bruce Hubbard. See Appendix Item 4 for a family tree of the Hubbard family with the descendants who were DNA matches.

Detailed Findings

Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton Family

Using clustering tools with Kathy P.'s *Ancestry* DNA results, matches from Jeanie's paternal line were discovered. By process of elimination with other shared matches, it was concluded that this cluster had to belong to Jeanie's paternal line.

Three matches to Kathy P. with a high amount of shared DNA were of particular interest; Iris D. (383 cM), Mark P. (374 cM), and Katherine T. (140 cM). In layman's

terms, centimorgans, or cM, is a unit of shared DNA. Therefore, a higher amount of shared cMs suggests a closer relationship than a lower amount of cMs.

Iris D. and Katherine T. both uploaded trees which were used to discover the most recent common ancestor between these two women was Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton. Iris D.'s tree was small but included the full names of her deceased parents which was useful.¹² Katherine T.'s tree was very detailed and included a link back to Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton.¹³ At the beginning of the research project, Mark P. had not uploaded a family tree. While the research was being conducted for the project, Mark P. began building his genealogical tree.

The Children of Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton

The 1920,¹⁴ 1930¹⁵, and 1940¹⁶ censuses provided evidence of Robert and Florence's marriage, and of the following eight children. The matches with asterisks are those whose descendants matched Kathy P. and Hazel S. on autosomal DNA tests. Those links will be discussed later in this report.

- i. *Elizabeth Hubbard born about 1911 in New York.
- ii. Robert B. Hubbard born about 1913 in New York.
- iii. Charlotte A. Hubbard born about 1914 in West Virginia.
- iv. Clark M. Hubbard born about 1915 in West Virginia.
- v. *Richard Hubbard born about 1915 in West Virginia.
- vi. Stanley B. Hubbard born about 1917 in Kentucky.
- vii. *Donald B. Hubbard born about 1920 in Alabama.
- viii. *Hampton Hubbard born about 1924 in North Carolina.

Robert B. Hubbard died on 14 April 1938.¹⁷ Since he was deceased prior to the estimated time of conception of Jeanie Maleski, he can be eliminated as a candidate for her father.

DNA Match- Iris D.

According to Iris D.'s public tree on *Ancestry*, she was the daughter of Richard Hubbard and Iris Hill.¹⁸ The *Ancestry* DNA results reported that Kathy P. and Iris D. shared 383cM. If Richard Hubbard were Jeanie Maleski's father, it would be expected that Kathy P. and Iris D. would share much more DNA as this would be a half-aunt biological relationship. The estimated range of shared cMs for a half-aunt relationship is 500-1446 with 891 being the average.¹⁹ Based on the low amount of shared cMs, this evidence revealed it was extremely unlikely that Richard Hubbard was Jeanie's father. Therefore, the most recent common ancestor for the two women would be Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton, and the relationship between Iris D. and Kathy P. would be half first cousin once removed. 383cM fits within the expected range of a half-first cousin once removed relationship.²⁰

DNA Match- Mark P.

According to Mark P.'s public tree on *Ancestry*, he was the son of Elizabeth Ann "Betty" Thompson who was deceased.²¹ The tree reported that her mother was Elizabeth Hampton Hubbard. Elizabeth Hubbard married Hobart Harvey Thompson on 10 February 1929 in Guilford County, North Carolina.²² The mother/daughter relationship between Elizabeth Hubbard and Elizabeth Thompson was confirmed by the following records:

- a. The “North Carolina, Birth Indexes, 1800-200” contained an entry for Elizabeth Ann Thompson, born 1929 in Wilson County to Hobart Harvey Thompson and Elizabeth Hampton Hubbard.²³
- b. The 1940 census in which Hobart Thompson, Elizabeth (Hubbard), and Elizabeth Thompson were all found living together in Clarke County, Georgia.²⁴ Elizabeth (Hubbard) was recorded as Hobart’s wife, and Elizabeth Thompson was recorded as his daughter.
- c. “U.S., Social Security Applications and Claims Index, 1936-2007” database contained an entry for an Elizabeth Ann Thompson who was born 15 May 1929, father Hobart H. Thompson and mother Elizabeth Hubbard.²⁵

Mark P. and Kathy P. share 374cM of DNA which fits within the estimations of shared DNA for half-second cousins.²⁶ Although this is on the very high end of shared DNA for that relationship, there is no evidence of a double cousin relationship between Mark P. and Kathy P. The high amount of shared DNA is simply due to chance. Given the current evidence, it can be confidently stated that Kathy P. and Mark P. are half-second cousins.

DNA Match- Katherine T.

According to Katherine T.’s detailed public tree on *Ancestry*, her maternal grandfather was Hampton Hubbard.²⁷ Hampton Hubbard married Florence Ann Holmes on 12 June 1946 in Orange County, North Carolina.²⁸ Katherine T.’s parents were presumed to be living since they were marked private on the tree.

After reviewing social media pages for Katherine T., it was discovered that her father was named Jeff T. A search of marriage records on *Ancestry* revealed that Jeff T. was married to Anne H.²⁹ It was then concluded that Katherine T.’s parents were Jeff T. and Anne H.

Anne H. was confirmed as the daughter of Hampton and Florence in her birth record which stated her mother's maiden name was Holmes. This information was consistent with the marriage record for Hampton Hubbard and Florence Holmes.

Since Hampton resided in North Carolina and he enlisted in the Navy on 3 October 1943, he is an unlikely candidate for Jeanie's father.³⁰ There is no evidence that he traveled to California or that Lois traveled to North Carolina around the time of Jeanie's estimated conception. Furthermore, if Hampton were Jeanie's father, then Katherine T. and Kathy P. would be half-first cousins. The estimated shared DNA of 140cM between Katherine T. and Kathy P. is very small compared to the estimated range of shared DNA for half first cousins.³¹ Therefore, their most recent common ancestor was Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton, which makes the two women half second cousins.

Given the current evidence, it can be confidently stated that Kathy P. and Katherine T. are half second cousins. The amount of shared DNA between the two women is consistent with individuals who share that genetic relationship.³²

DNA Match- Zach H.

Hazel Scullin, granddaughter of Jeanie Maleski, matched with Zach H. on *23andMe* with an estimated 367 cM of shared DNA. This was the highest match that Hazel S. had with an individual on Jeanie's paternal line. Zach H. and Hazel S. came in contact through Facebook messenger, and he revealed that his paternal grandfather was Donald Hubbard, and his father, Donald's son, was Dave H. Donald's marriage certificate recorded that his parents were Robert Clark Hubbard and Florence Hampton Hubbard which provided evidence that this was the correct individual.³³ In a private message to Hazel S., Dave H. confirmed that he was the father of Zach H., and his father was Donald Hubbard.

Further discussion with Zach H., Dave H., and Dave's brother, Ralph H., revealed that Donald Hubbard was stationed in Camp Pendleton, San Diego County, California

during WWII. According to the BIRLS database, he enlisted 2 October 1940 which places him in San Diego before Jeanie's estimated time of conception.³⁴

Assuming that Donald Hubbard was Jeanie Maleski's father, Zach H. and Hazel S. are half first cousins once removed. 367 cM of shared DNA between two individuals is within the expected range of shared DNA for this relationship.³⁵ In contrast, assuming that Donald Hubbard was not Jeanie's father, then the most recent common ancestor for Hazel S. and Zach H. would be Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton, and Hazel S. and Zach H. would be half second cousins once removed. However, 367 cM is above the range of expected shared DNA for a half-second cousin once removed relationship.³⁶ The range for half second cousins once removed is 0-341, with an average of 73.³⁷

Given the present genealogical and autosomal DNA evidence, it is extremely likely that Zach H. and Hazel S. are half first cousins once removed. Therefore, it can also be concluded that Donald Bruce Hubbard was most likely Jeanie's biological father.

Conclusion

Jeanie Maleski passed away before she could learn the identity of her biological father and meet her half-siblings. This research proved that her father was Donald Bruce Hubbard, son of Robert Hubbard and Florence Hampton.

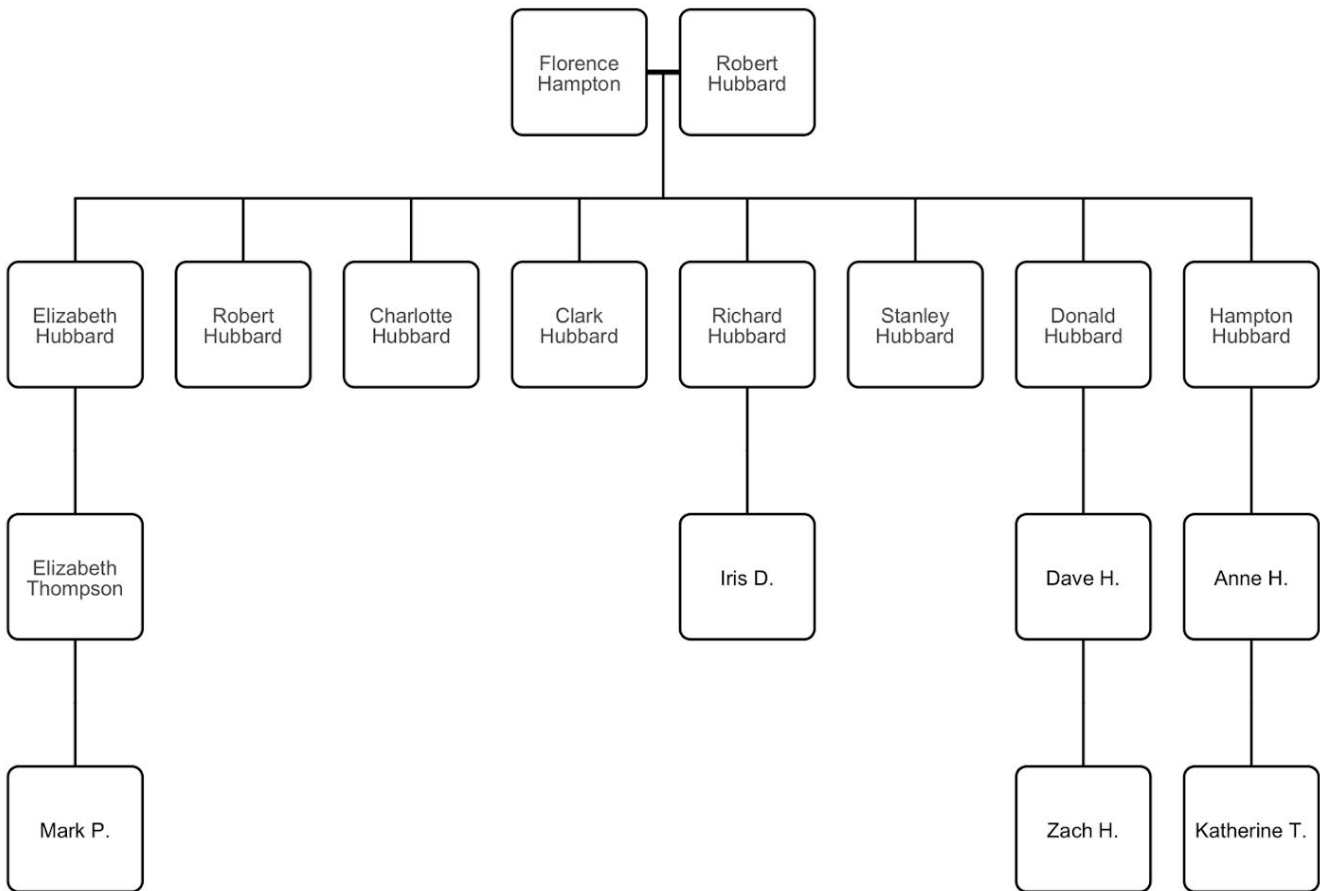
