


Figure 1-1: FamilySearch.org Family Tree screenshot showing Cynthia Dillard with unknown parents




Figure 3-1: FamilySearch Family Tree printed portrait pedigree showing the paternal ancestors of Diana Elder. Of the 15 pictured here, 12 lived in Chickasaw nation, Indian Territory.






Figure 3-3: Lorain, Scrub, Lola, and Della Shults with mule teams in Indian Territory, circa 1917




Figure 5-2: "U.S., Native American Enrollment Cards for the Five Civilized Tribes, 1898-1914," entry for Jacob, James H. and Calvin W. Meek, Ancestry (www.ancestry.com: accessed 10 February 2016), image 572.




Figure 6-2: Screenshot of Google Sheets spreadsheet research log for Cynthia Dillard




Figure 6-3: Screenshot of Research Ties
